

Score yourself in the following categories by circling the phrase in the box that best represents how you did in that area.

- Evidence and sources - ideas
- Transitions - organization
- Progression of ideas - organization
- Intro and conc - organization
- Elaborative techniques – example, explanation - ideas
- Connection among ideas – sentence fluency
- Conventions

For example, if you think you deserve a “4” in evidence and sources, circle that phrase about evidence and sources in the “4” box.

Remember that ideas and organization are most important.
They are the cake, the other traits are the icing.

After circling the criteria, circle the SBAC score that represents where most of your circles were. (3, 3-, ...)
